Creating Your Ezine Articles Account

- We start with Ezine Articles because they are a large directory that will not republish an article that has already been published.
- The most effective strategy for you to maximize your work is to submit to this directory, and once it has been published you can submit it to other directories.



Creating Your Ezine Articles Account

- Creating an account at Ezine Articles is easy and free.
- Start by logging on to www.ezinearticles.com and click on Submit Articles in the left-hand navigation. Don't worry about a pen name at this stage – just fill it in accurately.
- If you have any trouble with the process, click on the Video on the right-hand side to get help with the sign-up.

Creating Your Ezine Articles Account

- It's critically important to read the Terms and Conditions so you don't make a mistake in the first 10 articles.
- If you write 10 perfect, compelling, original articles, you will get Platinum Status.




Creating Your Ezine Articles Account

- Less than 15% of all authors get Platinum Status.
- Students with Platinum Status get their articles edited more quickly, which is a big boost when you are writing for profit.




Creating Your Ezine Articles Account

- Less than 15% of all authors get Platinum Status.

- Invest the time up-front in getting your first 10 articles approved and you'll reap the benefits later.

Create Your Author Name

- Once your account is created, it's time to fill in your author name and prepare to submit articles!
- Your author name does not have to be your real name.




Create Your Author Name

- A few quick rules:
 - If you are a PhD, an MD, or a Dr. you can put those titles after your name. If not, you can't. They check!
 - You have to use a first and last name – your author name can't be your company or URL.
 - Only one Ezine account per human, but you can have more than one author name.



Create Your Author Name

- Ezine Articles has already determined that it is most effective if you create a unique author name for each topic.
- This makes it easier to click on your author name and see more of your articles on the same topic.



Create Your Author Name

- Use one author name for skincare, one for water, one for fish oil, etc.
- They don't have to be radically different: you can just use variations on your main author name. For example:
 - Dan Ho
 - Dan D. Ho
 - Danny Ho
 - Daniel Ho

Creating Your Author Resource Box

- At the end of each article is an author resource box, where you can tell your audience a little about yourself.
- This is where you 'get the click' over to your site.




Creating Your Author Resource Box

- You want to be sure to include information that is relevant to your audience.
- No need to list your seventh grade track and field accomplishments or your passion for sushi - unless your articles are about those topics.




Creating Your Author Resource Box

- Here's a fast example of an author resource box for skincare:

- **Notice the following:**
 - Mention your name
 - Mention your site
 - Always let your audience know 'what's in it for them' - here it says they will find out how to deal with unwanted wrinkles.



Creating Your Author Resource Box

- Create an individual author resource box for every author name you have.
- You can create up to three author resources boxes per name, so if you are taking different angles in your articles, you can optimize your resource boxes accordingly.
